ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS FOR CURBSIDE PICK-UP

It is our goal to keep everyone safe and make our native plant sale an opportunity for you to get sustainably grown plants so that your gardens can be healthy as well. Please read the instructions to know what to expect.

The plant list has columns for each vendor — an asterisk means the plant is carried by that vendor. Columns showing light and soil conditions are a general guide. Our plant preview presentation on **May 14 at 7pm** will provide more information about each plant. We will send the zoom link to our mailing list, the morning of May 14 for that evening's presentation.

To pre-order for curbside pickup on May 30, please contact each vendor separately. Payment is requested at the time of ordering.

Our plant sale pickup is **Saturday, May 30 from 9am - 1pm** and your order will be waiting for you. You will not need to get out of your car, someone will bring plants to you.

We have room for 8 cars at a time to park. Someone will be directing traffic on the street to ensure that no more than 8 cars are in the parking area. To space out traffic pick-up times suggested by last name: **N-Z: 9-10AM, G-M: 10-11AM, A-F: 11AM-12PM.** Those unable to make earlier assigned slot: 12-1PM

At this time we don't know if vendors will have more plants to sell for walk-in customers. If there are plants available and you would like to shop, you will be directed to another area on the property where there is room for only 3 cars. We recommend pre-ordering your plants.
